



Detention Policy

After School Detention:

In the case of an After School Detention, parents/guardians will be informed by telephone/text using the VSware system, of their son's misbehaviour, and the date and time of the Detention. The details of the Detention will be available to parents/guardians on the VSware System where it will be recorded on the student's VSware page.

Should a meeting between parents/guardians and the teacher be necessary, it will be held by appointment only.

Any appeal against a detention should be addressed to the Principal.

Students who fail to sit a detention must present a letter from their parent/guardian on the day of the Detention to the Detention Coordinator explaining why they will be absent and give a commitment that they will attend the next detention. Failing this, the note must be presented to the Detention Coordinator on the morning following the detention. If this procedure is not followed to the satisfaction of the Detention Coordinator, then the student may be suspended for a day.

Lunchtime Detention can be implemented by a teacher where deemed appropriate.
